The status of positive cases for the new coronavirus

Last week, we confirmed that the following plant of our company tested positive for the new coronavirus in the PCR test.

- One employee at Kyushu Ichikoh Industries. Ltd. (321 - 4 Sankomoriyama, Nakatsu city, Oita prefecture)

We checked the person's activity history and identified people who had contacts with the person. For those identified, the Company instructed them to stay at home and perform PCR tests, and implemented thorough cleaning and sterilization of the workplace to avoid further infection.

Besides, there is no effect on our production in all of our plants.

We sincerely apologize for any anxiety or concern that this may cause to customers, suppliers, people in the surrounding regions and all the others concerned.

We will further continue to implement all possible measures to limit the risks for our employees from catching the virus, such as frequently washing their hands and wearing masks, and also have made maximum efforts to identify infected or possibly infected employees at the earliest possible stage. We will strengthen those efforts to avoid infection and to secure the safety and health of our employees.
